Bow Island/Foremost RCMP are looking for suspects after an early Thursday morning vehicle theft in the County of Forty Mile. Sometime in the early morning hours of June 13, a grey Nissan Titan was discovered in a field in the county, just off of Highway 879 and Range Road 90. The local farmer returned to his farm only to notice that his dark blue 2001 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 with the licence plate 41-B289 was stolen from his farm yard.

Upon further investigation, it was revealed that the grey Nissan Titan was stolen out of the Redcliff detachment area. It appears as though the culprit(s) dumped the Titan after hitting the ditch and then stole the dark Silverado pick-up.
